CONTENT SECTION

Content Section placements are visible to all visitors and are displayed on the VibrantVictoria HOMEPAGE, ARTICLE pages and the CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS LIST. Essentially any content that is not a part of the Forum Section will be served ads ,  and .









Rates

- 50% exposure is \$3.50/day with a 30-day minimum
- 100% exposure is \$7.00/day with a 30-day minimum

FORUM SECTION

300x250 pixel Forum Section placements are split into ads visible to unregistered visitors and all visitors. A registered visitor is someone who has registered an account on VibrantVictoria's discussion forum and has the ability to contribute to discussions. A registered visitor falls under the "all visitors" category as far as 300x250 pixel placements are concerned.

All visitors, which includes registered and unregistered visitors, have equal access to content on the discussion forum. However, unregistered visitors are unable to contribute content to discussions. Unregistered visitors make up the vast majority of visits to VibrantVictoria's forum.

Ad placements  and  are visible to all visitors to the forum, while  and  are only visible to unregistered visitors. All four placements are equally as effective as placements , , which are visible to all visitors, while placements  and  are located at the top of every forum page served to unregistered users.

Rates

- 50% exposure is \$4.50/day with a 30-day minimum

CONTENT & FORUM SECTION 1

Ad placement 1 is displayed on both the Content Section and the Forum Section. On the Content Section, the ad is situated atop every page loaded, including VibrantVictoria's homepage, article pages and construction projects list. The placement is also displayed for every registered visitor on the discussion forum atop every discussion forum page loaded, including the forum homepage, sub-forum listings and individual threads. Unregistered visitors see ad placements 7 and 8 in lieu of placement 1.

A registered visitor is someone who has registered an account on VibrantVictoria's discussion forum and has the ability to contribute to discussions. Registered users tend to view VibrantVictoria multiple times per day and are often "sources" of community-generated news and information.

Sub-forum Sponsorship

FORUM SECTION 11

Sub-forum sponsorship places an advertising text-link and message below the name of a sub-forum, such as the General Discussion sub-forum. The text link itself can point to any website and is bolded with a bright colour (such as red or pink). The remaining text can describe the link itself. An example would be:

Capital City Taxi - 24-hour taxi services throughout the CRD including low rates to the airport and ferry terminals.

In addition to the text link and text description, a 200x90 pixel ad banner is displayed for all visitors (registered and unregistered) to the sponsored sub-forum, including every thread and discussion within that sub-forum. Sub-forum sponsorship is purchased at one-year intervals.

Rate

- Text link, text description and 200x90 pixel ad, 100% exposure, at \$650/year, which is the equivalent of just over \$54 per month.
